Class 1: Prelim 1 (2006) Non-qualifier. Open to all.

Class 2: Novice 27 (2007) Non-qualifier. Open to all.
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BRC AREA 18 FOTH QUALIFIER

Class 3(a) Prelim. BRC HT90Q (2013) with 75cm (max) SJ.
Junior and Senior. Team and individual. (BRC Rulebook page 108)

Class 3(b) Novice. BRC HT100Q (2013) with 85cm (max) SJ.
Junior and Senior. Team and Individual (BRC Rulebook page 110)

Teams of 4: Two to ride Prelim/75cm, Two to ride Novice/85cm.

Numbers to qualify: Juniors: 1-4 teams entered: 1. 5 or more: 2
plus highest placed individual per arena not on a qualifying team.
Seniors: 1 – 12 teams entered 1. 13-20: 2. 21 or more: 3 plus highest
placed individual per arena not on a qualifying team.

Dressage and jumping will be on grass. Tests MAY be called.

*Please note that Class 3 requires Preliminary entries to be made to BRC HQ
(by Friday, March 24th 3pm at the very latest, preferably earlier, and detailed
entries with payment to WDRC by April 6th at the latest.*

Closing date for entries for classes 1 & 2: April 6th

Conditions of entry

Hard hats must be worn correctly fastened at all times when mounted. All competitors in Class 3 must have hats tagged with an ORANGE tag by a BRC official and comply with current BRC guidelines. A steward on the day will be able to do this.

The event is being run under British Riding Club Rules and it is the competitors' responsibility to familiarise themselves with these rules, which can be downloaded from the BHS website.

The dressage tests for Class 3 are on pages 108 and 110 of the BRC Rulebook 2017.

Tack may not be checked and it is the Class 3 competitors' responsibility to ensure they comply with BRC rules to avoid elimination by the judge.

The organisers of this event and the landowners have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

Late entries for Classes 1 and 2 may be permitted, subject to numbers, on condition they are paid for by bank transfer.

No entry fee for Classes 1 and 2 will be refunded after the closing date of April 6th without a vet's or doctor's certificate.

No entry fee for riders for whom Preliminary Entries were made with HQ for Class 3 will be refunded.

NOTE TO BRC TEAM MANAGERS (Class 3 only)

PLEASE remind your competitors that whether or not their horse's passport is on the area database, it must be produced before riding at the competition or it could incur disqualification. To save time on the day (ie remove the need for a full check) please ask them to update existing details or upload scans/photos and details onto the Area 18 website - www.brc-area18.org.uk - at least a week in advance of the competition. Area 18 is now issuing stickers with a 'valid until' date to help riders remember when the next booster is due.

Passports which do not have a sticker must be presented to the official steward before your number can be collected.

Class 3 entries MUST be paid for with a Riding Club cheque or online.

Entry fees:

Classes 1 & 2 (open dressage/warm up classes, non-qualifier): **£12 OR £6** if on an area team or WDRC member. Rider's name and class on reverse of cheques please. Please also specify which club you belong to and any other class you have entered on the same horse if on an area team.

Class 3

Team & Individual BRC qualifier: A CT team consists of four riders - two to ride the prelim class (section A) which consists of BRC HT 90Q (2013) with 75cm jumping and the other two to ride the novice class (section B) which consists of BRC HT100Q (2013) with 85cm jumping.

£88 per team (including medical cover contribution).
£22 per individual.

Entries for Class 3 must be on official BRC Area forms. Payment to be by club cheques or bank transfer only (email for details).

Preliminary entries for Class 3 should be received at BRC HQ by 3pm latest on March 24th.

Entries for warm-up Classes 1 & 2 should be received by the secretary no later than April 6th using the form overleaf.
