Important Competitor Information for BRC Equithème Intermediate Winter Championships

Information could be subject to change

- Flu vaccinations will be checked before the horse is unloaded at the venue. Once flu vacs are confirmed you will need to take the compliant voucher to the declaration marquee (this has moved from previous years) to collect your competitor number and stable number if booked. A map will be posted on the website and Facebook closer to the date with the location of declarations marked out. Anyone with stables booked who will be arriving after 1900 must contact the stable manager as soon as possible for details on what to do.
- Arena Walks for dressage will be as per the timetable. During an arena walk, competitors are permitted to ride around the outside of the dressage arenas. The arena walk on Friday is only for a short period due to time constraints so numbers may be limited in the arena, the steward will monitor but once you have been in the arena for a few minutes you may be asked to leave to allow someone else to walk around.
- For dressage, the published time is the time you should be entering the arena so please bear this in mind when warming up.
- The SJ course will be built on Thursday late afternoon for 100cm competitors. It will be set for the 90cm on Friday evening and will be available to walk after the build - the same will apply for Saturday evening. Changes can occur from time to time due to extenuating circumstances so if you are walking the course the night before; it's worth a double check that nothing has changed in the morning.

Course walks will be available before competition starts (see timetable). There will be the following breaks during competition hours to walk at:

100 Round 1 – 1000 (10 mins)

100 Round 2 – 1030 (10 mins)

110 Round 1 – before the class commences at 1330

110 Round 2 – 1510 (10 mins)

Senior 90 SJ Round 1 – 0946 (10 mins)

Senior 90 SJ Round 2 – before the second round commences at 1300

Junior 90 SJ Round 1 – 1015 (10 mins)

Junior 90 SJ Round 2 – before the second round commences at 1245

- 110cm competitors, please note that the time for this class may change depending on the jump off of the 100cm competition. It will not start before 1330 but may be worth checking with the Secretary to see how the day is going.
- For all SJ, second round times are an estimate as there may be gaps from withdrawals so be prepared to go early if needed. Check with the collecting ring steward on the day before your second round time.
- The SJ course may change for the second round and will go up in height at 5cm per round.

- Hook up is available and can be booked through the BRC stable manager, please contact megan.gibbs@bhs.org.uk.
- Dogs must be kept on short leads and wear ID tags. Dogs are not permitted in the main building.
- Exercise arrangements on Thursday are in the dressage warm up and the SJ collecting ring (no jumping of practice fences). After 1900 there will be no officials/paramedics available on site. Friday and Saturday exercise arrangements will be after competition has finished in the dressage warm up and the SJ collecting ring. Space may be available during competition hours but priority will be given to competitors. Access to competition arenas is strictly prohibited unless competing.
- Competitor numbers must be worn at all times when mounted either a bridle number on both sides of the horse or 1 back number.
- Hats to the correct standard must be worn at all times when mounted. It is encouraged to wear when handling horses on the ground.
- No exercising in any grass area.
- Please look in your programme on arrival at the event as this will have a site map with key points located.
- In the event of a time clash due to reserves please speak to the steward on the day, we aim to be as flexible as possible but try to stick to your published times. Where possible stick to your dressage time and move your SJ time.
- It is understood by the officials, competitors and volunteers that any photographs (and/or film footage) taken at the show by an official photographer may be used by the organiser or sponsors in future publications without payment. Anyone who does not want their photo taken must contact the secretary in writing.
- There is a strict no smoking policy in the stabling area and in the main arenas onsite.
- There will be a café which is run by Bury Farm on site and opening times will be publicised at the event.
