- Classes will be run over two rounds. Round 2 will be single phase. The first part may be up to 5cm higher than round 1, the latter part (jump-off) may be up to 10cm higher than round 1.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND NOTICES

*** IF THIS EVENT HAS TO BE CANCELLED DUE TO COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS HQ WILL REFUND PRELIM ENTRIES AND WDRC WILL REFUND STANDARD ENTRIES***

- 1) Refunds for other reasons will only be made on the production of a vet/medical certificate, received by the Entries Secretary, no later than 7th March 2020 and may be subject to an administration fee.
- 2) Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found so doing will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
- 3) INSURANCE: please ensure that all riders have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 4) The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident.
- 5) PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at the event; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer when entering the arena, before you start your round.
- 6) HORSES: Please do not leave horses tied up to the outside of lorries/trailers unsupervised; if horses are known to get distressed when left on trailers/lorries, please ensure that there is someone with them at all times. No hay nets to be tied to the outside of lorries/trailers please. Please do not muck out onto the lorry park and do remove any droppings.
- 7) DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT THE VENUE
- 8) Hat Tagging – please make sure that your riding hat has the correct aqua coloured hat tag from one of the recognised bodies – BE, PC and BRC - before you present to the ring. If you do not already have an aqua tag from one of these three organisations your hat will need to be inspected and tagged by an official steward. PLEASE WEAR A MASK while within a metre of others and when indoors.
- 9) Orders – will be strictly adhered to - if you arrive late for your round you will possibly have to wait to the end of the class and will only be allowed to jump if there is time and Covid safety guidelines are not breached.
Please be ready well before your estimated time and leave promptly after finishing.
- 10) Any rider attending the event on their own MUST give an emergency contact name and phone number to the Show Secretary.
- 11) All entries to Worcester & District Riding Club must be made either online or with a Riding Club cheque.

How to make a pre-entry payment TO HQ via the BRC entry/stabling website

1. Go to the prelim/stabling website via the following link <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2F> and log in if you already have an account, or click on the option to create an account if you don't already have one – this will be your login for all future payments you make.
2. Once logged in with an account, click onto 'Prelim Entries' or 'Entries' as it may appear. Do not click on stable booking system.
3. Ensure you click on the 'Qualifier Pre Entry' section. Once you are sure you are on the correct one, press 'make an entry'.
4. Select the relevant class(es) from the options given.
5. Fill in the details requested, then select a payment option from the bottom.
If you prefer to pay by cheque, do not proceed on the website but instead send in your cheque with the entry form by post, making sure it will arrive before the deadline for pre-entries.
6. If you discover you have missed off an entry payment and need to add another, or need to add one for another competition, click continue shopping and repeat the process.

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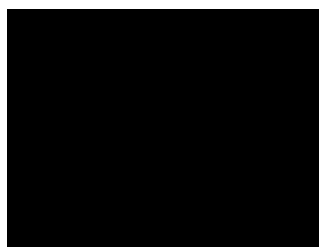
