

Conditions of Entry

Entrants for the unaffiliated non-qualifying classes must be aged 12 or more (no maximum age) on January 1st 2021. Non-BRC members must have their own insurance. We recommend you follow the BRC requirements for safety standards of hats and body protectors.

The dressage tests are the same for unaffiliated classes as for BRC and can be downloaded from:

Hard Hats: Hats must be worn correctly fastened at all times when mounted in accordance with 2021 British Riding Club Rules. Medical Arm Bands are strongly recommended and back protectors bearing a purple Beta Level 3 2009 or later, or blue 2018, must be worn on the cross country phase in accordance with 2021 British Riding Club Rules. Hybrid air jackets and air-jackets incorporated into a blouson style jacket are permitted. Exo body cages are permitted with a Level 3 2000 purple label. The secretary must be informed and given your allen key before your round.

Competitors in Area 18 Qualifying classes must have the aqua BRC, BE or PC hat tag. This event is being run under 2021 Riding Club Rules – please check for recent rule amendments on the BRC website.

The decisions of the judges and/or the official stewards are final.

If cancelled, administrative fees will be taken out of any refund.

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date without a doctor's or vet's certificate.

No horse may compete in 2 classes.

NOTES TO BRC AREA 18 TEAM MANAGERS

Please remind your riders to bring their horses' vaccination certificates/passports with them. If no certificate/passport is produced on request it could incur disqualification and it is illegal to travel your horse to the competition without it. Each BRC club entering this competition (and not running a phase) MUST provide at least 1 helper per team entered, + 1 if 1 – 4 individuals also enter from your club. EG 1 team + up to 4 ind = 2 helpers. 2 teams plus up to 4 individuals = 3 helpers. They will likely be asked to fence judge.

Names, addresses (postal and e-mail) and contact numbers of helpers must be emailed to chair@ludlowandddistrictridingclub.co.uk. Entries will NOT be accepted without the required minimum number of helpers identified. Failure to provide the required and expected number of helpers on the day may incur disqualification for your riders.
