SCHEDULE

Eventer challenge Course – jump a course of 7 – 10 show jumping obstacles followed immediately by at least 15 cross country jumping efforts.

Time:

Show jumping time based on 325 mpm

Cross country – optimum time (sensible pace) based on 435 mpm Challenge 80cm

450mpm Challenge 90cm and 475mpm Challenge 100cm

CLASS ONE: Eventer Challenge 80cm

B. BRC Junior Challenge 80cm Qualifier (Teams and Individuals)

CLASS TWO: Eventer Challenge 90cm

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Health and Safety

The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.

- 1) The judges/stewards should be treated with respect and their decisions are final. Anyone found to be rude/disrespectful to any officials will be asked to leave the venue.
- 2) Insurance: please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 3) No refunds will be made without a vet/doctor certificate.
- 4) If you pay a preliminary entry for a team/individual to BRC then you are obligated to pay BDRC the entry fee for the team even if you then decide not to send it to the competition.
- 5) All phases of an Eventer challenge are completed wearing xc dress so body protector and medical armbands compulsory. No stopwatches allowed.
- 6) Hats must be tagged with BRC orange tag (can be done on the day). Only a 'jockey skull' complying to BRC standards may for be worn, this must not have a peak type extension or noticeable protruberances above the eyes or the to the front. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used if required.
- 7) As with every event we will require helpers and clubs should anticipate providing 2 helpers per Team or multiples of four riders. Depending on entries not all helpers will be required and clubs will be advised as to their commitment as soon as possible. Fence Judges will need to be briefed prior to the start and expected to have access to a suitable vehicle. Refreshments will be provided.
- 8) Vet and doctor/paramedic ambulance will be on course, farrier may be on call.
