THIS COMPETITION WILL BE RUN UNDER 2017 BRC RULES – it is the team managers' and competitors' responsibility that they and their horses are eligible for these classes and are aware of all relevant Rules regarding the competition, tack and turnout etc

Competing horses/ponies' passport and flu vac details must be uploaded to the Area 18 website at least 7 days before the competition: www.brc-area18.org/pportflu.html

It is a legal requirement that you should have your horse/pony's passport with you.

SCHEDULE

Classes may be run in a different order than shown below depending on entry numbers

CLASS ONE: 80 Winter (maximum height in first round - 80cm)

- A: Senior Teams
- B: Junior Teams

CLASS TWO: 90 Winter (maximum height in first round – 90cm)

- A: Senior Teams
- B: Senior Individuals
- C: Junior Teams
- D: Junior Individuals

Both classes will be run over two rounds, with a jump –off for qualifying places if necessary; lower placings will be decided by scores over the two rounds and times in the second round if scores are equal. Teams will have three or four combinations, with the best three scores from each round counting; in Class One, where a team has two or less completing the first round, then those team members that have completed may only ride in the second round if time allows.

ROSETTES:

Class One (Winter 80) – team placings to sixth place for Seniors and Juniors

Class Two (Winter 90) - team and individual placings to sixth place for Seniors and Juniors.

Entries are only accepted on this basis.

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND NOTICES

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. A waiting list will be held if necessary.

- 1) Refunds will only be made on the production of a vet/medical certificate, received by the Entries Secretary, no later than 1st March 2017. Any refund may be subject to an administration fee.
- 2) Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found so doing will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
- 3) **INSURANCE:** please ensure that all riders have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 4) The judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
- 5) **PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at the event; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer when entering the arena, before you start your round.
- 6) **HORSES:** Please do not leave horses tied up to the outside of lorries/trailers unsupervised; if horses are known to get distressed when left on trailers/lorries, please ensure that there is someone with them at all times.

No haynets to be tied to the outside of lorries/trailers please.

Please do not muck out onto the lorry park and remove any droppings left behind.

- 7) **DOGS** – please ensure that any dogs are on a **SHORT** lead at all times and under control.
- 8) Hat Tagging – please make sure that your riding hat has the correct BRC hat tag before you present to the Tack Checker.
- 9) **Drawn Orders** – will be strictly adhered to - if you arrive late for your round you will possibly have to wait to the end of the class and will only be allowed to jump if there is time. Please be ready well before your estimated time.
- 10) Any rider attending the event on their own **MUST** give an emergency contact name and phone number to the Show Secretary, when collecting their number

The competition will be held in the Indoor Arena; the warm up will be in the Outdoor Arena; numbers in the warm up arena may be restricted if necessary.

DIRECTIONS TO MOORES FARM (GL19 4LY):

Directions from the M50

Jct 1 take the A38 south towards Tewkesbury. Before entering Tewkesbury turn right, over the Mythe Bridge and onto the A438 signposted to Ledbury. After about 4 miles turn left onto the B4211 signposted to Gloucester and Corse Lawn. Continue along Corse Lawn and having past the left turn to Chaceley, take the next left turn across the common, which leads to Moores Farm Equestrian Centre, immediately before the cricket pitch.

Directions from Gloucester / A40

Take the A417 north towards Ledbury and the M50. At Corse, just past the BP garage fork right onto the B4211 towards Corse Lawn, after passing the Corse Lawn Hotel on your left proceed for about 0.2 miles and take the right turn immediately after the cricket pitch. (There is a small horse chestnut tree on the corner) Moores Farm Equestrian Centre will be found at the end of this track.
