RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries will not be accepted unless payment has arrived in our bank account.

This event is being run under British Riding Clubs rules

Hard hats to the current acceptable standards must be worn at all times when mounted

Entries withdrawn after the closing date will not be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate although before the closing date we will accommodate substitutions. We will do our best to accept substitutions for last minute emergency withdrawals if we possibly can.

All persons attending the event do so at their own risk. The landowners, organisers or their officials will not be held responsible for any accidents or damage to persons, horses or property.

All competitors must have valid 3rd party public liability insurance.

No refunds will be issued for withdrawals after the closing date for entries without a doctor's/vet's certificate.

Dogs must be on a lead at all times.

The organisers will not be responsible for any accident or loss of property or otherwise from any cause connected with the show and it is a condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the organisers blameless and shall indemnify them against loss, damage or legal proceedings.

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey all signs and instructions of the organisers and all officials & stewards. Additionally, those attending this event must report any of the following incidents or accidents to the secretary or organiser of this event: property or vehicle damage, personal injury or personal illness.

Juniors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
