Horses may have won up to 299 BD points at the close of prelim entry in order to ride the Medium test and up to 425 BD points for the Adv Medium. Horses downgraded by BRC are eligible. All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £20 per individual and £26 per pair to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual or £20 per pair, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sort.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All individual competitors and at least one of the pair riders must hold BD Music/standard membership in order to compete.

All hats must have a visible orange BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

- The judges/stewards should be treated with respect and their decisions are final. Anyone found to be rude or disrespectful to any official will be asked to leave the venue.
- No refunds will be made.
- SSRC, the BHS, BRC and the land owners will not be held responsible for any loss, injury or accident to person, animal or property.
- Dogs must be on leads at all times and all fouling must be removed.
- The judge's decision and that of the BRC Official Steward is final. Any objections must be made in accordance with BRC rule G14I.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS FROM KINGS EQUESTRIAN

DIRECTIONS

- Look on Kings Equestrian website www.kingsequestrian.co.uk for directions to venue.
- Parking will be horseboxes on the right and trailers on the left, there will be a car park attendant to direct you.

ADMINISTRATION

- On the day, the vaccination checkers, Secretary and Numbers Secretary will be based in the Reception Area at the Kings Equestrian.
- Please ensure your horse's passport and flu vaccination history is registered with the Area Liaison Group database, <http://www.brc-area18.org.uk/pportflu.html> .
- Hats must be tagged with a BRC tag, check the BRC rule book for standards of hat required. Riders will not be admitted to the working-in arena without hats that are checked and tagged by the stewards.
- There are toilets located just outside the main entrance to the building.
- The Denny's Diner Café opens from 9.00 am onwards and sells hot and cold food, as well as homemade cakes.
- There will be a notice board located in the Café area, where the results will be posted.

HORSES

- **NO HORSES TO BE TIED TO TRAILERS OR LORRIES UNLESS SUPERVISED.** Horses that are known to get distressed when left in trailers/lorries **MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES AND NOT LEFT ALONE**
- Due to limited parking vehicles will be parked very close together actually making it impossible to tie to the sides of vehicles.
- **NO haynets to be tied outside to be eaten and dropped on the car parks.**
- Please pick up any droppings your horse may leave behind.

ARENAS

- The outside arena is to be used for warming up. We will be limiting numbers in this arena to those competitors about to compete. This is a Health and Safety directive.
- The Dressage Competition will take place in the indoor arena. No riders other than the next competitor to enter the arena are to stand around the entrance, please leave this area as soon as you have completed your test.

MUSIC

- All D2M competitors are required to be current BD music members and all music is to be licensed and correctly labelled. See BRC rule book for current rules on CD labelling.
- All music is to be handed in to the secretary at least 1 hour prior to the scheduled time of the test.
